2. Tags supplied by the Society

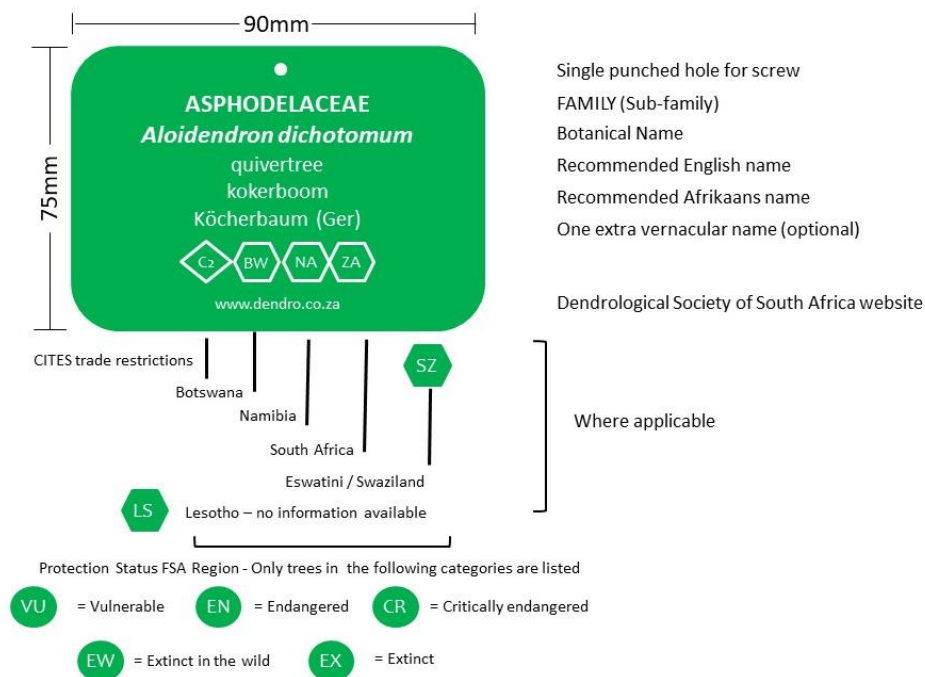
The Dendrological Society of South Africa provide tree tags and we have added our own flavour to the tags by introducing green tags for all other indigenous plants, story / interpretation tags, bonsai tags, the yellow tags for introduced trees as well as added more information on the protection status for indigenous trees and NEM:BA invasive status for introduced trees, where applicable. This was soon copied by various other suppliers.

Because of the cost involved to print these tags and regular name changes we deliberately decided not to carry any stock. All tree / name tags are therefore printed on order only.

The current colour schemes, standardized tag sizes, font theme, type settings and design layout are used by the Society, subject to:

- Availability of the plastic sheets in different colours – it does not really matter what colour we use – cost is the same, but availability in other colours turned out to be a challenge
- If we use different material, tag sizes, theme fonts, type settings, design, layout or anything other than the standardized units, each order must be set-up to those requirements and settings, and that will inflate the cost and delivery time
- One hole in the top (middle) of the tag, fitted with a nickel-plated eyelid, and if not submerged in water, will not rust
- Any client may however request tags to his own specifications, i.e., tag size, font type, theme, layout and information required on the tags, etc. In these instances, I will request a special quotation from our supplier and if accepted by the client the tags can be printed to the client's specifications
- Aluminum tags are also available

- Any deviation from these standards will result in an extra cost to the client

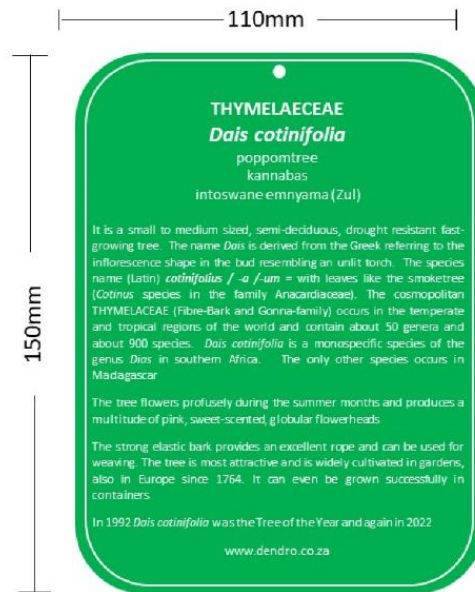
